

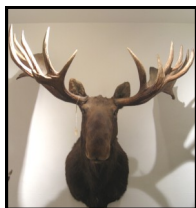
“Museums on the Move” Scavenger Hunt!

Look for this in the Everhart's **Visible Storage Gallery.**

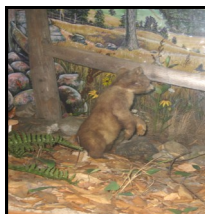
Where do moose find their food during the summer?
